



Title II Higher Education Act Quality of Teacher Preparation Report 2016 Institution Report Summary

During the 2014-2015 academic year, there were sixteen (16) approved teacher education programs in Nebraska. In addition to the requirement that all Nebraska institutions successfully complete the state approval process, thirteen (13) institutions have also attained national accreditation by the National Council of Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) or by the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC).

Institutions are required to submit annual reports in compliance with *Title II of the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 2008*. Information reported in the HEA institutional report includes: institution goals; Praxis I Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) or Core Academic Skills pass rates (Nebraska will begin to use Praxis II tests for certification September 1, 2015); admission requirements; candidate characteristics; clinical experience; student enrollment; and program completer/certification information. For purposes of these reports, an academic year is defined as September 1 – August 31.

The institutional reports were submitted in April 2016. The following table summarizes the 2014-2015 enrolled candidate and program completer information for each of the 16 institutions.
