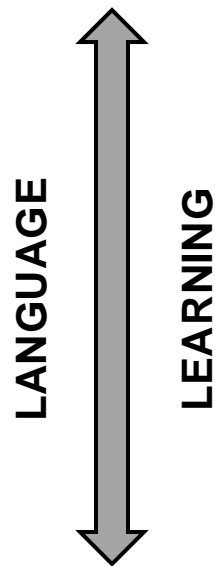

Language Features or Forms

1. Construct meaning from oral presentations and literary and informational text through grade-appropriate listening, reading, and viewing
