
Nebraska 21st Century Community Learning Centers

In 2016 the Nebraska Legislature appropriated \$250,000 to be awarded through competition to partnerships of school districts and communitybased organizations, and administered by the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE). This was a one-time appropriation to provide expanded learning opportunities (ELOs) through programming and other support activities and services in existing 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLCs). The term ELO describes an array of safe and structured programs that offer healthy growth, development and academic opportunities for youth. In Nebraska, 21st CCLCs are ELOs that provide educational and enrichment opportunities for K-12 youth when they're not in school (afterschool, during the summer and/or days when school is not in session).
