Every public school district in Nebraska having one or more nonpublic systems located within the public school district's geographic boundaries must complete this form. It is the responsibility of the public school district to submit the information from this form to the Nebraska Department of Education through the on-line collection in the Consolidated Data Collection, located in the Nebraska Department of Education portal by May 2nd. The public district will retain the completed paper form with signatures on file at the public school district office for 6 years.
