- 004.01E School year (1080 or 1032 hours) 400 for kindergarten (if provided)
- 004.02A1 Policies annually updated on file in each building
- 004.02A2 Policy on instructional hours
 - 1080 secondary
 - 1032 elementary
 - 400 kindergarten (if applicable)
 - Includes conditions for excusing students
- 004.02B1 School purposes and goals copy provided to each staff member
- 004.02B2 Curriculum guides or frameworks core curriculum areas, library and guidance
 - written composition in each core area
- 004.02B3 Cumulative files for each student
- 004.02B4 Athletic contest limitations
- 004.02C1 Head administrator has superintendent's endorsement
