

## NEBRASKA RESOURCES FOR ACTIVITIES AND BEST PRACTICES TO ADDRESS NINE MANDATORY ACTIVITIES

All nine required uses of funds, as defined in Section 135(b) of the federal legislation, must be addressed in one or more of the annual activities described in the annual application. If an application is submitted that does not clearly address all nine required uses of funds, the application will be denied and returned for changes.

For **each** of the annual activities, one or more of the nine required uses of funds must be identified by the corresponding letter for that required use of funds, followed by a clear description of **how** the activity addresses the identified required uses of funds.
