

ENHANCING EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING PROGRAM (EETP)

STATUS OF THE PROGRAM AS OF NOVEMBER 30, 2018

Distribution of EETP funds began with 2009-2010 awards. Since the inception of the EETP, 3270 EETP awards, totaling just over \$6.3 million, has been awarded to teachers across the state of Nebraska. During the 2011 legislative session, LB333 suspended funding for the 2011-12 and 2012-13 EETP award years.

STATUS OF THE BORROWERS

NDE has awarded EETP loans to 2438 Nebraska teachers since the program's implementation in 2009. Of those, 1050 have received funds in multiple award years. 594 individuals have 959 awards pending as the recipients continue to work towards completion of the graduate program in which they are currently enrolled, and 776 individuals have been forgiven 941 awards as recipients have fulfilled the teaching obligation of the program. The remaining loans are categorized as follows:

- 827 individuals have 1666 awards pending forgiveness as recipients fulfill their teaching obligation;
- 99 individuals have repaid 117 loans;
- 39 individuals are in repayment status on 61 loans because the recipient no longer qualifies for the loan forgiveness provision;
- 114 individuals declined an award; therefore those funds were redistributed;
- 19 individuals have 30 awards in "other" status.
