The Richard Katt Outstanding Career Educator will be required to present a session at the 2020 NCE Conference. The winning educators from each career field may also be asked to present a session at the conference.

- Recipients of the Outstanding Nebraska Career Educator Award are ineligible to receive this award again.

Judging

A judging team will select one educator from each of the seven designated career fields to be honored at the Nebraska Career Education Conference. These top seven finalist will be interviewed by a panel of judges on Monday, June 3 at the conference.
