



## USDA Nationwide Waivers for Child Nutrition Programs

All USDA nationwide waivers established in response to COVID-19 are in effect until the date listed or until expiration of the federally declared public health emergency, whichever is earlier. <b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #23: <a href="#">Meal Service Time Flexibility EXTENSION</a> (Previously Responses #1 and #17)</b>	In effect until August 31, 2020
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- Flexibility for time and duration of meal service.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #22: <a href="#">Non-congregate Feeding EXTENSION</a> (Previously Response #2)</b>	In effect until August 31, 2020
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- Meals and snacks do not need to be eaten onsite or in a group setting.
- Grab-n-go, drive-thru, and delivery methods are allowed.
- If using this waiver and the meal service time flexibility waiver, you can provide meals for more than one day at a time.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #3: <a href="#">No Enrichment Activity Required for At-risk and NSLP Afterschool Snack</a></b>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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- Only applies to at-risk afterschool programs and NSLP offering afterschool snack.
- No requirement to provide enrichment activities with the meal service.



<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #24: <a href="#">Meal Pattern Flexibility EXTENSION</a> (Previously Responses #4 and #13)</b>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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- Sponsors are allowed to claim meals for reimbursement if they are unable to meet meal pattern requirements after exhausting all options to provide requirement components. Examples: the grocery store or distributor is limiting supplies, grocery store or distributor is out of stock, or the distributor has delivery issues.
- Sponsors must make every effort to meet the meal pattern to the greatest extent possible.
- If you choose to use this waiver, institutions must complete the [Request Form](#) and receive approval from the NDE Office of Nutrition Services.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #25: <a href="#">Parent/Guardian Meal Pick Up EXTENSION</a> (Previously Response #5)</b>	In effect until August 31, 2020
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- Only available to Sponsors who make use of the non-congregate feeding waiver.
- Parents/guardians can take home meals without the enrolled child (or adult for adult care centers participating in the CACFP) present at pick-up.
- Sponsors must ensure meals are only going to parents/guardians of enrolled children/adult participants.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #6: <a href="#">Nationwide Waiver for Community Eligibility Provision Deadlines</a></b>	In effect until August 31, 2020
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- LEAs using CEP may use data from April 1 through June 30, 2020 to calculate Identified Student Percentage (ISP).
- LEAs must submit ISP data to NDE by June 15th.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #9: <a href="#">Monitoring Flexibility</a> - State Agencies &amp; SFAs</b>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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- Grants flexibility to State agency and SFA to not conduct on-site monitoring requirements for the school meals program.



<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #10:</b> <a href="#">Monitoring Flexibility - Sponsors</a>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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- Grants SFSP Sponsors flexibility to conduct site visits and reviews as desk audits without an on-site visit.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #11:</b> <a href="#">Monitoring Flexibility - State Agencies</a>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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- Grants State agency flexibility to the SFSP to conduct site visits and reviews as desk audits without an on-site visit.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #12:</b> <a href="#">60-day Reporting Requirements for January and February 2020</a>
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- USDA provided extensions for submitting January and February 2020 NSLP claims.

**January 2020 claims are due by April 30, 2020.**  
**February 2020 claims are due by May 29, 2020.**

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #14:</b> <a href="#">Closed Enrolled Sites use Area Eligibility</a>	In effect until September 30, 2020
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- Closed Enrolled sites can use area eligibility to establish SFSP sites in needy areas; these sites do not need to collect income eligibility documentation from participants.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #15:</b> <a href="#">SFSP First Week Site Visit waived</a>	In effect until September 30, 2020
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- SFSP sponsors do not have to conduct first week site visits at all SFSP sites.



<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #16: <a href="#">Offer Versus Serve (OVS) allowed for non-SFA SFSP sponsors.</a></b>	In effect until September 30, 2020
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- SFSP Sponsors that are not SFAs are allowed to use Offer Versus Serve as part of meal service. If you intend to use this option, please contact the NDE Office of Nutrition Services.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #18: <a href="#">School Wellness Policy Triennial Assessment</a></b>	The new assessment deadline is June 30, 2021
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- LEAs are allowed one extra year to complete the School Wellness Policy Triennial Assessment, extending the deadline to June 30, 2021.

<b>COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #21: <a href="#">Extend Unanticipated School Closure Operations Through June 30, 2020</a></b>	In effect until June 30, 2020
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
