IDEA Maintenance of Fiscal Effort (MOE) Eligibility Standard for Special Education –
Opening June 5 – Close July 20.

School district eligibility for receipt of Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA Part B) funds are contingent upon maintaining fiscal effort from year to year. Districts are to report within this application estimated special education expenditures, receipts, and resident child counts to establish eligibility for the receipt IDEA Part B funds through the Grant Management system (GMS) during the 2020-2021 year.
