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PURPOSE

To provide information about Nebraska School District/System responsibilities related to data reporting.

- Who is responsible for reporting data about a student (and possible data necessary to be submitted);
- What district does student performance data become attached to for purposes of accountability and public reporting.

The scenarios and different situations among Nebraska schools are unique and diverse, but the information provided within this publication intends to provide clarity on specific situations.

DEFINITIONS

<u>Attendance</u>: Attendance is the time a student is present on days when school is in session. The Attendance data is derived from the reported absence data and the calendar will be used to calculate average daily attendance.

<u>Courses:</u> Used to collect information regarding courses and teachers from students in grades prekindergarten through 12 complete during a particular school year.

Discipline: Data about student discipline incidents and the schools' disciplinary actions taken. Some discipline information is needed for state, federal, or CRDC reporting. Additional data may be displayed on the ADVISER dashboard.

District/System of Membership: The approved or accredited district/system where the student received the majority of their instruction – includes Public Districts, Nonpublic Systems and Special Purpose Schools.

District of Residence: The Public School District where the student resides. Resident shall mean a person who has his or her residence in a place. It should be noted that the Legislature has specifically provided in Section 79-215 (1) R.R.S. that, except as otherwise provided in § 79-215 R.R.S., a student is a resident of the school district where he or she resides and shall be admitted to any such school district upon request without charge.

Enrollment: A cumulative set of all students enrolled in a district/system at any time during the school year and represents a student's most current information.

<u>Nebraska Department of Education Student ID</u>: An NDE Student ID is required for all students attending or provided services from a Nebraska District/System.

Post School Survey: For all 12th grade Career Education Concentrators identified as a completer with diploma in the previous school year.

Programs:

Career and Technical Education: Optional for 2019-2020 – Not a separate program record in 2020-2021. (Data for this program will no longer be required to be submitted in 2020-2021, as it will be determined from course records under Perkins V.)

Early Childhood Education: A cumulative set of students; include all students served in the specified Early Childhood Education Program at any time during the school year.

Homeless Education: A cumulative set of students; include all students eligible for Homeless Education services at any time during the school year.

Rule 18 Interim-Program School: A cumulative set of students; include all students served by a Rule 18 Interim-Program School at any time during the school year.

Special Education Program: Collects data on students with verified disabilities on an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP). This includes point in time count, October 1 each year and the year end, June 30 count.

Section 504 Program: An indication that a student is receiving services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; include all students receiving services at any time during the school year. NOTE: For School Year 2020-2021 Section 504 will be collected as a Student Characteristic and Not a Program.

Title I Program: Collects information on a variety of Title I services a student may have received at any time during the school year.

For additional Program information, please see Section 8 in the ADVISER Data Elements document.

<u>School Enrollment</u>: Collects information on student enrollment events, both enrollment and withdrawal, during the school year.

School of Membership - For most students, the School of Membership is the school where the student is enrolled for the majority of their instruction. For students attending a program (e.g. focus, Rule 18, ESU, alternative programs, or career academies), the School of Membership is the school where the student would be enrolled either due to residence in the district or due to assignment.

School Year: June 30 is used as the logical representation of the end of a school year.

APPENDIX A – EXEMPT SCHOOL/HOME SCHOOL PROCESS AND CODING FOR ENROLLMENT

Exempt School/Home School Process and Coding for Enrollment

Parents or legal guardians notified the school district they are filing for an exemption election. School district should check the Exempt Schools – School District Report (found in the NDE Portal within the Data Collections tab).

IF Started/Working:

This status indicates the parents or legal guardians have created an account to file through the Nebraska Exempt School online system, but have not submitted to NDE. **Note**: It is not considered an exemption election filing until it is submitted. The student should remain enrolled and if the student is not attending school, the district <u>will</u> report the student absent.

IF Submitted/Pending NDE Review:

The student should remain in enrollment until the Exempt Schools – School District Report (found in the NDE Portal within the Data Collections tab) shows the student with a status of Submitted. The student's enrollment code reported is 205 (not enrolled eligible to return), using the <u>date</u> the Exempt Schools – School District Report shows the student as having a "Submitted" filing. The district <u>will not</u> continue to report the student absent. **Note:** Review turnaround time is 6 weeks if the filing is complete. See Under NDE Review, Exempt Date or Filing is Incomplete below.

IF Submitted/Under NDE Review:

NDE is awaiting further information from the parents/legal guardians before the review can be completed. The student's enrollment code reported is 205 (not enrolled eligible to return), using the <u>date</u> the Exempt Schools – School District Report (found in the NDE Portal within the Data Collections tab) shows the student as having a "Submitted" filing. See Exempt Date or Filing is Incomplete below.

Exempt Date:

Once the filing has been reviewed and found to be complete, the status of the submission will show an Exempt Date next to the student's date of birth. As of the Exempt Date, the student can be reported as a 201 (transfer out).

 All families receiving exempt status will receive a letter signed by the Commissioner of Education "acknowledging" their choice to receive exempt status (exempt schools are acknowledged only, they are not approved or disapproved). An Acknowledgement Letter is issued only if the submission is complete. Exempt status must be renewed annually by July 15th.

Filing was Incomplete. School has been notified:

IF a filing "Submitted/Under NDE Review" and subsequently the parents/legal guardians have not responded to NDE's requests for information, the resident district Superintendent will be notified of noncompliance (as per Section 006 of Rule 13). On the Exempt Schools – School District Report (found in the NDE Portal within the Data Collections tab), the student will show as deactivated with the notation "Filing is incomplete. School has been notified." Add the student back into the district's student information system for follow-up related to truancy as per the district policy. Showing the student with enrollment code 205 (Not Enrolled Eligible to Return).

Canceled:

Prior to NDE's processing, the submission has been canceled due to various reasons; e.g. duplicate submission (filed online and by paper), parents changed their mind, etc. Check the Exempt Schools – School District Report (found in the NDE Portal within the Data Collections tab) and if there isn't an active application, the student should remain enrolled and if the student is not attending school, the student should be reported as absent.

Related Notes:

Remember that until NDE processes an exemption election filing, the initial data included in your district report may not be accurate.

Changes in the report are reflected in real time; the status shown is the current status.

Once a filing is submitted through the Nebraska Exempt School online system, they will appear on the Exempt Schools – School District Report.

Paper filings received by NDE via regular mail or drop-off only (faxes and emails are not accepted), are typically entered within 2 business days; other than during the summer months, which could take up to 10 business days.

• Exemption elections are effective upon receipt by NDE (the "Submitted" date). This means the parents or legal guardians do not have to wait to begin homeschooling until the filing is reviewed (refer to Rule 13, Section 005). However, if upon review by NDE of the filed materials it is discovered the filing is incomplete or improper, parents/legal guardians are notified and have a stated time by which it must be completed or corrected to be effective.

If a particular student or family is not listed at all, more than likely, they have not filed with NDE. The student should remain enrolled and if the student is not attending school, the district will report the student absent.

For Students who are part of the Enrollment Option Program, and the parents are homeschooling these students, they will be listed on the Resident district's report only. The Resident & Option districts need to communicate this information to each other. The option should be cancelled as well.

If, after reviewing the report, there is a family listed that does not reside in your school district or if you have questions on the status of a filing, send an email to beth.bolte@nebraska.gov. Include in the email the name of the student, date of birth, name of the parents, and the address. Be sure to identify your school district in the email as well.
